

CITY OF BRAWLEY NOTICE AND INVITATION TO BIDDERS BACKFLOW PREVENTER REPLACEMENT PROJECT SPECIFICATION NO. 2024-05

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids for the BACKFLOW PREVENTER REPLACEMENT PROJECT will be received by the City of Brawley (City) in the Public Works Office, 180 South Western Avenue, Brawley, California 92227, until 2:00 P.M. Local Time on November 5, 2024. At this time, they will be publicly opened and read aloud. No late bids will be accepted.

The Contract for the work advertised will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. The city reserves the right to reject all bids, waive any irregularities, or dispense with further bidding.

<u>BID BOND</u>: Shall be completed in the forms provided as per Instructions to Bidders <u>and</u> accompanied by a Certified Check, Cashier's Check, or a Bid Bond executed in favor of the City of Brawley in an amount of ten percent of the bid to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: Liquidated Damages of \$500.00 per calendar day are included in this project.

<u>PROJECT DESCRIPTION:</u> The Work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals as required by the plans, specifications, and contract documents. The scope of work for this project includes removing and replacing various Reduced Pressure (RP) Backflow and Double Check Backflow devices at various locations in the City of Brawley. The backflows are 1-inch RP Backflow, 2-inch RP Backflow, 4-inch RP Backflow, 4-inch DC Backflow, and 6-inch RP Backflows. Replacements of Backflows must be Wilkins, Zurn, or Approved Equal. Some backflows need to be raised to grade.

COMPLETION OF WORK: The work must be completed within <u>30</u> calendar days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed.

<u>CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE:</u> The contractor shall have a State of California Classification "A" or "C36" Contractor's license to perform the work. A bid submitted by any contractor not properly licensed during bid opening shall be considered non-responsive and rejected.

<u>MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING:</u> A <u>Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting</u> will be held to familiarize all interested bidders with the conditions of the project and the project site. The meeting will convene at **10:00 a.m.** at the Public Works Department, 180 South Western Avenue, Brawley, CA, on <u>October 17, 2024</u>, with a walkthrough of the project site after the meeting.

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS-REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT FOR AWARD: No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations according to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations according to Labor Code section 1725.5.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations

<u>STATE PREVAILING WAGE RATES:</u> According to the Labor Code of the State of California, the Director of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rate of wages and employer payments for health and welfare, vacation, pension, and similar purposes applicable to the work to be done. These rates and scales are attached to this package, but the Contractor must check the website for any changes to all trades used. The contractor to whom the contract is awarded and the subcontractors under him must pay not less than these rates for this area to all workers employed in executing this contract.

<u>APPRENTICES:</u> Attention is directed to the provisions of Sections 1777.5 and 1777.6 of the Labor Code Concerning the employment of apprentices by the Contractor or any subcontractor under him. It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to ensure that all persons shall comply with the requirements of said sections in the employment of apprentices.

RETENTION: The city will retain a portion of the Contract price as law requires. The Contractor may substitute securities for the retained funds withheld by the City. Alternatively, the Contractor may use an escrow agreement in the form prescribed under California Public Contract Code 22300.

BIDDING DOCUMENTS: Bidding documents may be requested at 180 South Western Avenue, Brawley, CA, or via email at agutierrez@brawley-ca.gov, or by calling (760) 587-4320 Monday through Friday from 8 am - 12 pm and 1 pm - 5 pm (closed from 12 pm -1, Bidding documents will be emailed to the bidder at the bidder's request; however, the City will not be responsible for delays.

Only those firms that have requested the bid documents from the City will be directly provided with any addendums that may be issued for this project before the bid opening date. If you requested from a plan room, it would be your responsibility to get your addenda updates from them, as we have no list of where you asked for anything other than the city.
