4. PUBLIC APPEARANCES/COMMENTS

- a. Parks and Recreation Manager, Rachel Fonseca shared that she was able to secure a \$250,000 contribution from the Brawley Union High School District for the Lions Center pool project. Fonseca also shared that she applied for a State Grant in the amount of \$177,952, and that she will also apply for a Program Income Waiver through CDBG to assist with the pool project.

Fonseca also mentioned that she will combine the Program Income and \$194,700 from a donation to complete the Lions Center Reroofing project.
